

2019 Championship Show Class Schedule:

- **Thursday - 9/19/19** - Classes begin at 7 a.m. The last classes of the day will be Classes 22 & 23 Int. & Jr. Hunt Seat Equitation. Classes 3 thru 8 and classes 19 thru 23 will be run simultaneously.
- **Friday - 9/20/19** - Classes begin at 7 a.m. with Class 24 Junior Bareback. The last class of the day will be Class 41 Sr. Egg & Spoon Pleasure Horse. Horsemanship classes will be run simultaneously.
- **Saturday - 9/21/19** - Classes begin at 7 a.m. with Classes 42 and 43 (Sr. 50+ Poles and Sr.+ Poles) running simultaneously. Class 42 thru Class 57 will be run simultaneously. The last class of the day will be Class 58 4-In-A-Line.
- **Sunday - 9/22/19** - Classes begin at 7 a.m. with Class 59 Sr. 50+ Jumping Figure Eight. The royalty coronation will be held after Class 65 Pony Jumping Figure Eight. The last class of the day will be Class 67 Ribbon Race.
- **Monday - 9/23/19** - Classes begin at 7 a.m. with Class 68. Jr. Egg & Spoon Game Horse. The last class of the day is Class 77 Sr 50+ Barrels.

Qualifications:

- Qualification dates for the **2019** WSCA Championship Show are from 8/20/2018 thru 8/18/2019. You must have qualified between those dates to be eligible to enter.
NOTE: Entries postmarked after 8/19/2019 must pay "post entry fee rates". NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Riders must be a member in good standing of a WSCA saddle club as of May 31, 2019, and their name must appear on the WSCA Membership List.
- *Riders must have placed either first or second at a WSCA judged horse show in a WSCA qualifying class within the qualifying dates listed above.
- Riders must ride in their appropriate age class, and correct pony size corresponding to age. Class and age divisions are to be determined as of January 1, 2019. Class and age divisions are:

Pet Pony	48" and under pony, rider 10 years and under
Pony	54" and under pony, rider 13 years and under
Pee Wee	Horse over 54", rider 10 years and under
Junior Rider	Horse over 54", rider 11 to 13 years
Intermediate Rider	Rider 14 to 17 years
Senior Rider	Rider 18 to 34 years
Sr+ Rider	Rider 35 to 49 years
Sr 50+ Rider	Rider 50 years and over
- A rider and/or horse may enter and ride in only ONE 4-in-line barrels team.
- A Non-Stock Type Western Pleasure class is open to horses such as Arabians, Morgans, and Saddlebred-type horses that are **lighter in build** than the stock horse breeds. They also should move with an obvious degree of carriage.
- All Ponies **MUST** be measured at the Champ Show prior to their class. Ponies must show in their appropriate size and age appropriate class.
- * **A COPY OF EACH HORSE'S COGGINS PAPERS ARE REQUIRED TO BE SENT WITH THE ENTRIES. Bring the original Coggins paper along to the show to be available to the show veterinarian upon request.**
- Refunds for entry fees will be given only in the case of an illness or injury to the horse or rider. A doctor's letter, or a letter from your veterinarian stating the reason you cannot participate, **MUST** be submitted to the show office or postmarked no later than October 1, 2019. Refunds for any other reason will not be given.
No refunds will be given for stalls.
