

The 2024 WSCA Championship Horse Show entries will be entered through Horse ShowTracker. It is a very user-friendly program that manages all of your entry needs and documents. Be sure to watch the Horse Show TrackerTutorial video FIRST (link below) as this will make the process smoother and simpler!

HOW TO ENTER



ENTER ONLINE AT horseshowtracker.com

If you want your data saved or other advanced features, subscription is required to Horse Show Tracker (entering your first two horse shows are FREE, subscriptions start at as little as \$1.99 a month.)

KEY STEPS TO ENTRY SIGN UP:

1. Set up your horseshowtracker.com account

- ★Be sure to use the exact exhibitor names/spelling that you qualified under. (same as champshow.org)
- ★ Also make sure you have your Saddle Club listed on your account at champshow.org

2. Manage People: Add all the exhibitors you will be entering here.

★Be sure to use the exact exhibitor names/spelling that you qualified under.

3. Manage Horses: Add all the horses you will be entering here.

★Be sure to use the exact horse names/spelling that you qualified under.

★Make sure to add your coggins for each horse.

- 4. Select Online Entry: Click on WSCA Championship Horse Show.
- 5. Click Manage Entries
- 6. Click + ENTER A HORSE: Select the horse you would like to enter.

★At this point you may need to choose the payment method for the horse's entries.

7. Click + ADD A CLASS: You can search for class by Discipline, Division or the easiest is to type in the class number in the search bar.

HOW TO ENTER CONTINUED...

8. Click the class you would like to enter, \checkmark the box next to the class and click save & save again.

- ★Repeat this process for all the classes you would like to enter with the horse/rider combination.
- *Make sure you are only entering classes that horse/rider combination are gualified in. {Qualifications will be verified, you can check your qualifications on your champshow.org account, fvi the date savs 2023 Qualifications, but they are 2024}
- 9. Entering Multiple Horse/Rider Classes; ie: Tandem Bareback, Rescue Race, Ribbon Race & 4-In-A-Line **★ONE EXHIBITOR/HORSE from the team will enter & pay for the class via horseshowtracker.com**
 - *Example: If your horse is being used for Tandem Bareback or Rescue Race, enter & pay for the class under your horses entries via your horseshowtracker.com account. You will then need to fill out the Multiple Horse/Rider Class Information Form. THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT, AS IT WILL GIVE US YOUR TEAM INFORMATION. This form can be found at: https://rb.gy/mg9abn
 - *Example: For multiple horse events; Ribbon Race or 4-In-A-Line. **One team member** will enter and pay for the class via their horseshowtracker.com account. You will then need to fill out the Multiple Horse/Rider Class Information Form, THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT, AS IT WILL GIVE US YOUR **TEAM INFORMATION.** This form can be found at: https://rb.gy/mg9abn

10. Adding a Stall: <u>Every horse</u> needs a stall added to their list of classes.

- \star Stalling options are listed as classes. (see the chart below for the class #'s)
- ★Example: you would like a Full Show Stall Horse Barn, type in 200 in the search bar, the Full Show Stall Horse Barn Option will come up, click save & save again. This will put this stall option under your horse's entries on your invoice.
- **★ REMINDER if stalling with a group**, you are to purchase your stalls independently online, but also please be sure to have 1 person from your group submit a WSCA Champ Show Group Stalling Form AFTER the entry deadline: August 26 - August 31 by emailing it to wscastalling@gmail.com. 11. Repeat the above entry/stall steps for each horse you are entering.

12. Adding Parking/Electrical Camping/Side-By-Side Permits

- \star These options are also listed as classes, (see the chart below for the class #'s)
- *Example: you would like a Non-Electrical Parking Permit, (reminder every trailer/rv that is parked in the parking lot needs either a non-electrical or electrical permit visible) type in 210 in the search bar, the Non Electrical Parking Permit will come up, click save & save again. It does not matter what horse/ exhibitor combo you tie these items to, but the permits will be in the name of the exhibitor it is under.

HOW TO ENTER CONTINUED...

- 13. When you are done adding entries, stalling and parking/electrical, click Submit to Show.
- 14. Once you hit submit, you will have a chance to review your invoice, look it over closely, if there is something you need to edit, you can click the back arrow on the top left.
- 15. If all looks good, click continue. A 'Please verify your email' window may pop up, click verify email or skip. You can then click pay to complete your entries & payment will be made. You will receive a summary/invoice of your entries/stalling/etc. to your Horse Show Tracker account email.
